They crossed the dreadful morass in boats, hewn out of solid trees, bringing stone to build a haven for men who were at one with Him.

A place of peace for Canice, Cronan and other brethren, an area of light after the darkness, and idolatry of Crom Dubh's Druid worship.

The Holy Island Monaincha called the Isle of the Living.

To Sean Ross and unto the Green Road came Cronan, bringing learning and hospitality, people flocked to his side, and Roscrea prospered and grew.
