FLAME OF LOVE OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY INTRODUCTORY TALK in ST. CRONAN'S CHURCH, ROSCREA

At 3pm on Sunday, 8th May

John Sullivan, Director for International Dissemination for the Flame of Love Movement, will give an Introductory Talk on this Marian Devotion given to Elizabeth Kindelmann in 1962.

John will explain how it is a devotion of Grace, how it's Mary's plan for Evangelisation in the current times, what this devotion actually does, how it supercharges other devotions, how it is about families and union with Jesus. The Flame of Love Devotion was approved by the Church in 2009.

A short introduction to the devotion will also be given at the 11.30 mass on 8th May.
