May Reflection on The Rosary

In May, we are surrounded by new growth; the earth has renewed itself. We too have been renewed this Easter and our relationship with Jesus Christ continues to grow and flourish. Jesus gave us His Mother at the foot of the cross and she in turn has given us The Rosary. The Rosary is not only a spiritual practice but through its reverent repetition can lead us to inner peace....and our busy hectic lives need inner peace.
