## Current Restrictions

- **Public Masses are now permitted with 50 people in attendance, however...**

In line with recommendations received from Bishop Fintan, where a church is bigger and can safely accommodate larger numbers, there is an increased capacity permitted attending for Mass. Therefore, we can accommodate **80** people at Mass in St. Cronan's Church Roscrea.

Weddings and funerals are capped at **50** people regardless of size of premises.

Masses available on parish radio/webcam also

- **Baptisms – maximum permitted 10**
- **Weddings – maximum permitted 50**
- **Funerals – maximum permitted 50**
- **First Friday and pastoral visits suspended**
- **Churches remain open for private prayer 10.30am to 2pm**

**Anniversary Masses for all churches within the Pastoral Area can be booked through the Parish Office.**

## Safeguarding

Any person whose work or activity involves access to Children or Vulnerable Adults, whether in a full-time, part-time of voluntary capacity with the Diocese of Killaloe must be vetted.

Those who need to be vetted; Clergy, Sacristans, Parish Safeguarding Reps., Youth Group Leaders, Eucharistic Ministers, Baptismal Teams and all other roles that bring a person into direct contact with children or vulnerable adults through his/her ministry, work or activity.

What is required for Vetting:

- 2 Forms of ID, proof of Address and the other has to have a recent photo. Public Service Cards are not accepted as a form of ID.
- Completed Vetting Form

In Order to facilitate this procedure. The Vetting Forms will be in each of the Parish Church's and we ask people to come to the Parish Office with their forms and the necessary documentation as soon as possible. Office hours are Tuesday to Friday 10am- 1pm.
