Our Parish Accounts are prepared by our Accountant and overlooked by our Parish Finance Committee and then sent onto the Diocese.

The Diocese, being a registered Charity has the amalgamated Accounts of the Diocese audited before they are submitted to the Charities Regulator.

As you will be aware, the parish holds two separate accounts.

The Church Account is used for the day to day running of the parish, the Priests Account is used for the payment of the Priests monthly stipend.

The Priests Account holds only the monies received from the 8 Priests Collections (Yellow envelopes). From this Account the Priests receive their monthly stipend.

The Church Account holds all other Parish Income i.e. monies received from the weekly envelope and basket collections, the candelabras, rental of parish office and land, donations given to the parish for weddings etc, occasional bequests and monies we receive from Revenue through the CHY3 Tax Refund Scheme. All parish expenses are paid out of the Church Account. Each parish pays an Annual Levy to the Diocese to support the Diocese and Bishop and the running of Diocesan Programmes. We paid €27924 in 2022 to the Diocese.

It is worth noting that our expenses for Light & Heat €27332 in 2022 is an increase of almost 50%? on the previous year. This reflects like your home the huge increase in energy and fuel prices over that period.

If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask us priests. On your behalf I THANK our Accountant, Lorraine Shaw & our Parish Finance Committee for overseeing the financial welfare of our parish.

But, most of all I want to THANK you, our very loyal Parishioners, for your generous support of our parish and of us as your priests. In these uncertain times when money is limited your generosity is humbling.
