The Grotto of Lourdes

It was in the Grotto of Lourdes, that the Virgin Mary, the
Mother of God, appeared 18 times to Bernadette Soubirous
between 11th February 1858 and 16th July of the same year.

It was in this place that Bernadette accepted the Lady's
invitation: "Would you do me the grace of coming here for 15
days?" (3rd apparition)

Inside the Grotto is the spring of water that Bernadette
uncovered in response to the Lady's request; "Go to the spring,
drink and wash" (9th apparition)

It was on this rock that the Basilica of the Immaculate
Conception was built in response to the Lady's wish "Go and
tell the priests that a chapel should be built here and that people
should come here in procession" (13th apparition)

It was here that the Mother of God revealed her Name on 25th
March 1858, making this place the Shrine to the Immaculate,
"I AM THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION" (16th apparition)
