### Indulgences at the Commemoration of All Souls

This year, due to present circumstances arising from the "covid-19" pandemic, the period during which Plenary Indulgences can be gained for the Faithful Departed is extended to the entire month of November.

You can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the faithfully departed. The elderly, the sick and all who for grave reasons are unable to leave their homes – due, for example, to restrictions imposed by competent authorities during the pandemic so as to avoid crowded gatherings in sacred places – can still gain the Plenary Indulgence by praying for the dead.

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1<sup>st</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> November. The conditions mentioned above apply also for this.
