Jubilee Year of Mercy Logo

The logo, designed by the Jesuit Fr Marko I Rupnik, in the shape of an almond, depicts Jesus as the Good Shepherd carrying on his shoulders Adam, who represents all of humanity. It speaks to us of the God who takes all of us on himself. It also suggests the image of the lost sheep & reminds us that God goes in search of those who feel most distant & far away. A striking feature of the logo is that Jesus & Adam share a common eye, indicating that both see life from each other's perspective. Jesus & all humanity see eye to eye with each other. The three concentric blue circles get lighter as we move outward, representing a movement from darkness to light.
