This year our Trócaire box tells the story of Kumba, a 7 year old girl from Freetown, Sierra Leone. "At the age of just 7, Kumba has already survived an Ebola outbreak that killed 4,000 people & a mudslide that killed 1,000 people. Her young life has been spent in an almost constant state of crisis. Tragically, she is far from alone. A 7 year old in Syria has never known peace; a 7 year old in Gaza has survived two separate wars; a 7 year old in South Sudan has experienced both famine & civil war in their short life. The Lenten campaign comes at a time when conflict in many parts of the world has left millions of people at risk of famine & disease.
