### Suicide Alertness “Safe-Talk”

A Safe-Talk Programme, to equip people with skills to recognise signs of suicide & enable people to become suicide alert, will take place in the **NLP Centre**, New Line, Roscrea, on **Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> March from 5.15pm to 9.30pm**. This **FREE TRAINING** prepares people to identify & recognise individuals who may be having thoughts of suicide & teaches people how to provide practical help & support by connecting them to the appropriate resources & services by using the steps of TALK...Tell, Ask, Listen and Keep safe. Training is **provided by the HSE**. Participants must be **over 18** years of age. This training is not suitable for those who are currently vulnerable or recently bereaved by suicide. It is advisable to allow two years or more prior to attending Safe-Talk training if bereaved by suicide.
