Trócaire Appeal

Archbishop Eamon Martin has officially announced an emergency church appeal towards Trócaire's work in Eastern Africa on **next weekend, 22nd/23rd July.**

Prolonged drought has led to severe food shortages across East Africa. Approximately 25 million people are in need of emergency assistance. Trócaire's response in South Sudan, Kenya & Ethiopia focuses on food & water, while in Somalia, they are running health clinics treating people for malnutrition, cholera & other health issues. An emergency church collection will ensure that Trócaire can continue to scale up relief efforts & respond to the dire needs of these people.
